RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ESTABLISHED TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE AWARDING OF CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND FOR MATERIALS BY COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS, AND DISTRICTS IN CASES OF EXTREME EMERGENCY.

1 *Resolved*, That the special commission, established by chapter
2 eighty-eight of the resolves of nineteen hundred and sixty-five,
3 and revived and continued by chapter one of the resolves of the
4 current year, shall, in the course of its investigation and study,
5 consider the subject matter of current house documents num-
6 bered 898, requiring public bids for any leases made or licenses
7 granted in connection with the operation of any concession upon
8 property owned or controlled by the commonwealth, or any of
9 its departments, divisions, boards, commissions or agencies,
10 and authorities; and 1535, providing for competitive bidding on
11 construction projects of public utility companies and redevelop-
12 ment projects.
