The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPROVAL OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 161A of the General Laws, as appear-
2 ing in section 18 of chapter 563 of the acts of 1964, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting
4 in place thereof the following two sentences: — The approval
5 of the fourteen cities and towns shall be determined by a ma-
6 jority vote of their mayors (or city managers in the cases of
7 Plan D or Plan E cities) and chairmen of selectmen with the
8 vote of each city and town counted as on the advisory board
9 pursuant to section seven; provided, that the vote of at least
10 four municipalities shall be required to constitute the majority
11 of the fourteen cities and towns. The approval of the advisory
12 board and of the sixty-four cities and towns shall be determined
13 by majority vote of their mayors or city managers and chair-
14 men of selectmen present and voting thereof with the vote of
15 each city and town counted as on said advisory board; pro-
16 vided, that fifty per cent or more of the total votes as set forth
17 in said section seven is represented at such meeting.
