By Mr. Randall, a petition of William I. Randall for legislation to authorize certain banks to contribute to the building fund being raised for the benefit of the Framingham Union Hospital, Inc. Banks and Banking.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN BANKS TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE BUILDING FUND BEING RAISED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FRAMINGHAM UNION HOSPITAL, INC.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subject to the limitations upon amounts that may
2 be expended in any one fiscal year contained in section fifty-
3 seven of chapter one hundred and sixty-eight, and section fifty-
4 five of chapter one hundred and seventy, both of the General
5 Laws, so far as applicable, any bank established in the town of
6 Framingham, Hopkinton or Holliston may, by vote of its di-
7 rectors, or of its officers having the power of directors, con-
8 tribute such sum or sums of money as said directors or officers
9 may determine to be reasonable to the seventy-fifth anniver-
10 sary expansion fund being raised for the benefit of the Fram-
11 ingham Union Hospital in said town of Framingham.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
