AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS AT STATE COLLEGES BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE STATE COLLEGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter seventy-three (73) of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding at the end the following paragraph.
- 3 The board of trustees of the state colleges is hereby author-
- 4 ized and directed to grant certain scholarships annually in
- 5 number equal to two percent (2%) of the preceding Septem-
- 6 ber full-time day student enrollment to worthy students who
- 7 are residents of the commonwealth and who possess the requi-
- 8 site ability and who are in need of financial assistance. The
- 9 board of trustees of the state colleges shall establish at each
- 10 state college a scholarship committee consisting of the academ-
- 11 ic dean, the dean of admissions, and the registrar of the col-
- 12 lege to select the recipients of the scholarships available.
