AN ACT REQUIRING THE COMMONWEALTH TO PAY THE FULL PREMIUM FOR CERTAIN HEALTH AND OTHER INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 8 and inserting in place thereof the following
3 section: —
- 4 Section 8. With respect to any period of insurance authorized
5 by this chapter, the premium for such insurance shall be paid
6 by the commonwealth and no contributions shall be made by
7 any employee, retired employee or dependent.
