AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO PAY THE COST OF INCOME PROTECTION INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 180 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 17D the following section: —

3 Section 17E. The Commonwealth and its political subdivisions including regional school districts are hereby authorized
4 to pay part or all of the cost of the premiums for income protection insurance purchased by employees of the Commonwealth, its political subdivisions and regional school districts.
