AN ACT REQUIRING THE ITEMIZING OF PREMIUMS FOR MOTOR
VEHICLE INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 113K the following section: —
3 *Section 113L.* Every bill or statement rendered by an in-
4 surance company or insurance agent or broker for the pay-
5 ment of premiums for insurance in connection with a motor
6 vehicle shall be so itemized as to clearly indicate the premiums
7 charged for compulsory motor vehicle liability insurance, cov-
8 erage in excess of such compulsory insurance, and each other
9 type of coverage.

2. Section 123M. Every bill or statement introduced in an in-
 ternal company or insurance agent or broker for the pur-
 pose of payment for insurance in connection with a policy
 which shall be so labeled as to clearly indicate the person
 insured for compensation, motor vehicle liability insurance, con-
 sists in whole or in part of such company, insurance, and each other
 type of coverage.
