AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF CLAIMS BY INSURANCE COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 47 of Chapter 175 shall be amended by adding the
2 following: — "Eighteenth, Whenever an insurance company
3 issues a draft in payment on a claim, it shall not stop payment
4 thereon unless there is a definite question of fraud in the
5 original claim.
