AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE CLERK OF A DISTRICT COURT MAY MAIL
SUMMONSES FOR CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 25 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the Tercentenary Edition and as most recently amended by
3 adding after the last sentence the following: — Or in the case
4 of a summons issued under a complaint for any violation of any
5 statute, by-law, ordinance or regulation relating to the opera-
6 tion or control of a motor vehicle by such service or by mail-
7 ing an attested copy to his last known and usual place of abode
8 not less than fourteen days before the return day.
