RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF RICHARD E. SNELL OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 or special law to the contrary, that for the purpose of dis-
3 charging a moral obligation of the Commonwealth and sub-
4 ject to appropriation, there be allowed and paid out of the
5 state treasury to Richard E. Snell of Boston such leave and/or
6 loss of wages for the period of June 12, 1965 through May 1,
7 1966; and in addition thereto payment in the sum of Five
8 Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Three Dollars for medical
9 bills incurred as a result of injuries to the said Richard E. Snell
10 in the performance of his duties as an officer in the Metro-
11 politan District Police Department.
