## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE HOLDING OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES FOR ILLEGAL PARKING IN THE CITY OF BOSTON UNTIL FINES HAVE BEEN PAID OR SECURITY FOR THEIR PAYMENT DEPOSITED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The fifth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 263 of the acts  
2 of 1929, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 228 of the acts  
3 of 1966, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the follow-  
4 ing sentence: — If a vehicle is removed pursuant to a rule or  
5 regulation adopted under this section, such vehicle shall be  
6 held until all charges lawfully imposed for such removal and  
7 storage following the same have been paid and, if in the  
8 calendar year in which such vehicle is so removed and in the  
9 preceding calendar year, ten or more notices, in the aggregate,  
10 have been affixed to said vehicle as provided in section twenty  
11 C of chapter ninety of the General Laws, due notice has been  
12 received that either the fines provided in such notices have  
13 been paid or security for the payment thereof has been  
14 deposited.
