RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO MAKE AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO A SUITABLE MEMORIAL TO MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES FROM THE COMMONWEALTH WHO LOST THEIR LIVES IN VIETNAM.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house, and five  
3 persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established  
4 to make an investigation and study relative to a suitable me-  
5 morial to be established in the commonwealth to honor the  
6 members of the armed forces of the United States from the  
7 commonwealth who lost their lives in Vietnam.
