AN ACT AUTHORIZING CITIES AND TOWNS TO CONTRACT FOR THE RENTAL OR LEASE OF DATA PROCESSING EQUIPMENT FOR PERIODS NOT EXCEEDING FIVE YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 For the rental or lease of data processing equipment. Con-
- 4 tracts for such equipment may be made for periods not ex-
- 5 ceeding five years.
