The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CERTAIN MARKERS ON THE SOUTHEAST EXPRESSWAY IN THE CITY OF QUINCY, AND GRANTING TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF SAID CITY CONCURRENT JURISDICTION WITH THE POLICE FORCE OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OVER THE WILLIAM T. MORRISSEY BOULEVARD IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby di-
2 rected to place suitable markers at the Sooren M. Alemian
3 bridge; the James E. Kennan Memorial bridge; the P.F.C.
4 Daniel Marini Bridge; the Staff Sergeant Matthew Paul De-
5 Luca Memorial Bridge; and the P.F.C. Roger F. Schneider
6 Overpass, in the city of Quincy, to replace stolen bronze
7 plaques formerly placed at said bridges and overpass.

1 SECTION 2. The police department of the city of Quincy
2 shall have jurisdiction and control, concurrently with the
3 police force of the Metropolitan District Commission, over
4 that section of the William T. Morrissey Boulevard which lies
5 between Hancock Street and Sea Street in said city, the
6 designation of which will, under the provisions of chapter
7 three hundred and eighty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred
8 and sixty-eight, be changed, on January first, nineteen hun-
9 dred and sixty-nine, to Quincy Shore drive, and of the side-
10 walks, beaches and other areas adjacent thereto.
