AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF CERTAIN COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION SYSTEMS IN CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 No one shall construct or operate a community antenna
- 2 television system in a city or town of the commonwealth
- 3 prior to July first, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, unless
- 4 prior to September first, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight he
- 5 had been so authorized by such city or town, and prior to
- 6 November first of said year had entered into a contract for,
- 7 or had engaged in, the construction or operation of a com-
- 8 munity antenna television system in said city or town.
