AN ACT TO FURTHER PROMOTE THE BREEDING OF THOROUGHBRED HORSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subparagraph (g) of section 2 of chapter 128 of the General
2 Laws as appearing in section 2 of chapter 807 of the acts of 1969
3 is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence therein and
4 inserting the following: —

5 To aid in the promotion, development and encouragement of
6 the breeding of thoroughbred horses, by offering as a prize to the
7 breeder of a Massachusetts bred thoroughbred horse, a cash prize
8 equal to twenty percent of the first, second, or third prize
9 according to the position the said horse officially finished in a
10 pari-mutuel thoroughbred horse race conducted in the common-
11 wealth, and a further prize of twenty-five percent of the prize
12 awarded to said breeder to the owner of the stallion which sired
13 said horse, provided said stallion stands in the commonwealth.

REPORT
OF THE

COMMISSIONERS OF THE BUREAU OF AGRICULTURE,
IN ANSWER TO A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE SENATE,
MAY 10, 1906.

1. Chapter 20 of the laws of the Commonwealth, as amended by Chapter 128 of the Acts of 1906, is hereby amended by striking out the first section thereof and inserting the following:
2. To aid in the promotion, development and conservation of the business of agricultural lands, by offering such lands to the tenant of a Massachusetts agricultural farm, a cash price equal to twenty percent of the first section of this part, according to the portion the said land actually occupied at the time the said agricultural farm was acquired by the said tenant, and a further right of twenty percent of the price received to and payable to the tenant or his heirs, assigns and assigns, provided said tenant stands in the same relation
