AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF AN EXECUTIVE SECRETARY BY THE BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF ARCHITECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 44D of Chapter 13 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding after the first sentence therein the following
3 sentences: —

4 The board shall employ an executive secretary, who shall be a
5 registered architect, and shall determine his duties and salary.
6 The executive secretary shall not be a member of the board and
7 shall not be subject to the provisions of sections forty-five to
8 fifty, inclusive, of chapter thirty or to the provisions of chapter
9 thirty-one.
