## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CANCELLATION OF AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 113A of chapter 175 is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following sentence to provision (2): — If the reason for cancella-
- 3 tion is for non-payment of premium, the company shall not issue
- 4 the notice provided for in this provision until it has notified the
- 5 named insured in accordance with all the provisions of this pro-
- 6 vision regarding notice of cancellation of the amount of the de-
- 7 ficiency of the premium owed the company for all the insurance
- 8 provided at least fifteen days prior to the issuance of any notice
- 9 of cancellation for non-payment of premium

Approved by the Joint Resolutions of the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America, this 15th day of June, 1902.

At a Conference held at the City of Boston, on the 15th day of June, 1902, the following members of the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Massachusetts were present:

Section 115A of chapter 177 is hereby amended by striking the following words in the second sentence: "If the amount of the tax for the year is not paid in full, the amount of the tax for the year shall be paid in full by the 15th day of July, 1902." The words "for the year" shall be inserted at the end of the second sentence in accordance with all the provisions of the law relating to the collection of the taxes of the State, and the amount of the tax for the year shall be paid in full by the 15th day of July, 1902.
