AN ACT DESIGNATING THE MONSON STATE HOSPITAL IN PALMER AS THE MONSON STATE SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Monson State Hospital in the town of
2 Palmer shall be designated and known as the Monson State
3 School.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 14 of chapter 19
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 735 of
3 the acts of 1966 is hereby amended by striking out in line 7 the
4 words "state hospital" after the word Monson and inserting in
5 place thereof the words: — "state school".

1 SECTION 3. The first paragraph of Section 14A of chapter
2 19 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 735
3 of the acts of 1966 is hereby amended by striking out in lines 4
4 and 5 the words "state hospital" after the word Monson and
5 inserting in place thereof the following words: — "state school".

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take place upon its passage.
