AN ACT TO ENABLE INCREASED ENFORCEMENT OF MARINE FISHERIES STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 130 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after Section 9 thereof the following new Section: —

3 *Section 9A.* — Inspection without Warrant.

4 The Director, his assistants, a Natural Resource Officer or
5 Deputy may, without warrant, inspect any boat, vessel, fish car,
6 bag, box, locker, package, crate, any building other than a
7 dwelling house, any motor vehicle as defined in Section 1 of
8 Chapter 90, or other vehicle or any other personal property in
9 which he has reasonable cause to believe and does believe that
10 fish taken, held, kept, possessed, transported or held for trans-
11 portation or sale within the jurisdictional boundaries of the
12 Commonwealth may be found, in order to insure the enforce-
13 ment of the provisions of Chapters 130 and 131 of the General
14 Laws.
