

Accompanying the fifth recommendation of the Department of Public Health (House, No. 170). Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE LICENSING OF VENDING MACHINES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 309 of chapter
2 94 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 3 of chapter 487
3 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking out the last
4 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
5 A label, provided by the commissioner, bearing the operator's
6 license number, shall be conspicuously displayed on each vending
7 machine.

1 SECTION 2. The fourth paragraph of said section 309 of
2 said chapter 94, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the words "location" or "locations" wherever they appear in
4 subdivisions (1), (2), (3), and (4), of said paragraph, and inserting
5 in place thereof the words "vending machine" or "vending
6 machines", respectively.

1 SECTION 3. Section 309 of said chapter 94, as so appearing,
2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following
3 paragraph: —

4 Notwithstanding any provisions above, if a person operates
5 only one vending machine, his license shall be in effect for a
6 period of three years rather than annually.

1 SECTION 4. Section 310 of said chapter is hereby amended
2 by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: — The
3 commissioner shall have the authority to promulgate such

4 regulations as may be necessary to clarify or implement the
5 provisions of sections three hundred and eight to three hundred
6 and thirteen, inclusive.
