## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ISSUE RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS AND CONDUCT OF LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVES AND WATCH, GUARD OR PATROL AGENCIES, AND RELATIVE TO WEAPONS AND EQUIPMENT CARRIED BY SUCH LICENSEES AND THEIR EMPLOYEES OR AGENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 147 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 22 the following section: —

3 *Section 22A.* The commissioner may promulgate such rules  
4 and regulations as may be necessary to insure proper standards of  
5 skill required of licensees, and employees or agents of such  
6 licensees.

1 SECTION 2. Section 29 of said chapter 147, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 42 of the acts of 1970, is hereby  
3 further amended by inserting after the third sentence, the follow-  
4 ing sentence: — The commissioner may promulgate rules and reg-  
5 ulations relative to such weapons and equipment.

1 SECTION 3. Said section 29 of said chapter 147 is hereby  
2 further amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in  
3 place thereof the following sentence: — Whoever violates any  
4 provision of this section or of any rule or regulation promulgated  
5 hereunder or whoever violates any rule or regulation promulgated  
6 under the provisions of section twenty-two A shall be punished  
7 by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.
