AN ACT TO REPEAL THE RACIAL IMBALANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws as most recently amended by
2 Chapter 641 of the Acts of 1965, is hereby further amended by
3 repealing Sections 37C and 37D, and Chapter Fifteen of the
4 General Laws as most recently amended by Chapter 641 of the
5 Acts of 1965 is further amended by repealing Sections II, IJ, and
6 IK.
