AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CELEBRATION OF CHRISTMAS AND OTHER FESTIVALS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Local school boards are authorized and impowered to set
- 2 appropriate guidelines for the celebration of Christmas and other
- 3 festivals observed as holidays in public schools within the local
- 4 school district for the purpose of furthering the educational,
- 5 cultural and social experiences and development of children.
