AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WORCESTER TO APPROPRIATE AND PAY A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY TO ALBERT J. BOUFFARD FOR SERVICES RENDERED, PAYMENT OF WHICH WAS INCORRECTLY COMPUTED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The City of Worcester is hereby authorized to appropriate and
2 pay to Albert J. Bouffard the sum of four hundred and seventy-
3 five dollars (\$475.00) for services rendered by him during the
4 period from 1968 to 1971. Said appropriation corrects a compu-
5 tation of his salary which overlooked increments due.

City of Worcester

1 *Ordered:* That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby author-
2 ized to file with the 1973 session of the General Court, special
3 legislation to authorize the City to correct the error that incor-
4 rectly computed the salary of Albert J. Bouffard, a teacher at
5 Burncoat Senior High School, in the amount of four hundred and
6 seventy-five (\$475.00) dollars.
