AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTIFICATES OF MUNICIPAL LIEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out in the fifth sentence thereof, as
3 appearing in Chapter 537 of the Acts of 1958, the
4 words: — “except the taxes, assessments or portions thereof,
5 rates and charges which have accrued within the three years
6 immediately preceding the date of the certificate.”
