## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REBATE OF REGISTRATION FEES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the  
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the first  
3 sentence, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter  
4 742 of the Acts of 1969, and inserting in place thereof the  
5 following sentence: — A person who, before the first day of the  
6 seventh month next following the effective date appearing on the  
7 certificate of registration, for any reason other than sus-  
8 pension or revocation surrenders his number plates and registra-  
9 tion certificate and does not apply for registration of another  
10 vehicle but who, on or before the first day of the month next  
11 following which date shall be at least one month prior to the  
12 expiration date appearing on said certificate of registration,  
13 files in the office of the registrar a written application for a  
14 rebate shall be entitled to a rebate of one half the fee paid for  
15 the registration of a vehicle of which the plates and registration  
16 certificate have been surrendered as aforesaid; provided, that no  
17 such rebate shall be paid except upon a certificate, filed with  
18 the comptroller, setting forth the facts, and signed by the  
19 registrar or his authorized agent; and provided, also, that the  
20 rebate shall be paid out of the fees received for the registration  
21 of motor vehicles and trailers without specific appropriation.
