## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AMOUNT OF PENSIONS AND RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE PAYABLE TO CERTAIN FORMER TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 962 of the acts of 1971 is hereby amended by striking  
2 out section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following  
3 section: —

4 *Section 1.* The annual amount of every pension, retirement  
5 allowance or annuity payable to any former employee of the  
6 commonwealth, or to any school teacher who was employed by  
7 the commonwealth or by any county, city, town or district, who  
8 at the time of retirement had attained age sixty and had  
9 completed at least twenty years of service and who has been  
10 retired for a period of at least twenty years prior to the effective  
11 date of this act, or to any school teacher who was employed by  
12 the commonwealth or by any county, city, town or district  
13 retired for disability and had completed at least twenty years of  
14 service and who has been retired for a period of at least twenty  
15 years prior to the effective date of this act, shall, if the annual  
16 amount of such pension, retirement allowance or annuity  
17 together with any increases, including cost-of-living increases, is  
18 less than three thousand dollars, be increased to three thousand  
19 dollars.
