By Mr. Landry of Waltham, petition of Richard E. Landry that state employees be granted travel time allowance when required to report to places of employment other than their usual places of employment. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRAVEL TIME ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary or any
2 rule or regulation by the division of personnel and
3 standardization, any employee of the commonwealth whose
4 duties require him to travel and report to a place of employment
5 other than his usual place of employment shall be granted travel
6 time allowance in excess of fifteen miles at the rate of ten
7 minutes plus one minute for each additional mile.
