AN ACT REDUCING THE PERIOD AFTER WHICH THE EXCISE IMPOSED ON CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES IS DUE AND PAYABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 60A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the seventh sentence, as appearing in
3 chapter 142 of the Acts of 1970, and inserting in place thereof
4 the following sentence: — The excise hereunder shall be due
5 and payable at the expiration of thirty days from the date
6 upon which the notice was issued by the collector or the
7 commissioner pursuant to this section.
