### **AN ACT EXEMPTING LOTTERY PRIZES FROM STATE TAX.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 813 of the Acts of 1971 is amended by adding after  
2 section 32, the following new section 32A, no state taxes of  
3 any kind shall be imposed upon the proceeds from a prize  
4 awarded by the State Lottery.
