AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO TAKE OVER THE CARE, CONTROL AND MAINTENANCE OF PART OF ROUTE 116 IN THE TOWNS OF CHESHIRE AND SAVOY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to take over the care, control and maintenance of that
3 portion of state highway Route 116 as lies between the town
4 lines of the town of Adams and the town of Savoy in the town
5 of Cheshire and that portion of Route 116 as lies between the
6 town lines of the town of Cheshire and the town of Plainfield
7 in the town of Savoy.

By the Committee on Education and the Arts, in response to a resolution of the House of Representatives, passed July 2, 1964, relating to the Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Land Management, and to the Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Land Management, and to the Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Land Management.

That the Department of the Interior and the Bureau of Land Management be authorized to carry out the following program of research and development:

1. To conduct a study of the effects of the proposed program on the environment and on the health and safety of the public.

3. To conduct a study of the effects of the proposed program on the culture and on the heritage of the public.

4. To conduct a study of the effects of the proposed program on the quality of life and on the well-being of the public.

5. To conduct a study of the effects of the proposed program on the social and on the political life of the public.

6. To conduct a study of the effects of the proposed program on the scientific and on the technological life of the public.
