### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLOWANCE FOR CLERICAL ASSISTANCE IN THE DISTRICT COURTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 striking out section 69, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 4 *Section 69.* The mayor of the city of Boston, if the district
- 5 court is in Suffolk county, or the county commissioners, if the
- 6 district court is in any other county, shall approve for the annual
- 7 allowance for clerical assistance such amounts requested by the
- 8 presiding justice.
