RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO VOLUME OF CASES IN THE SEVERAL DISTRICT COURTS IN SUFFOLK COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of
3 representatives, and three persons to be appointed by the
4 governor, one of whom shall be a judge from Suffolk county, is
5 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
6 and study relative to the volume of cases of each of the several
7 district courts located in Suffolk county for the purpose of
8 making recommendations as to the equal distribution of the
9 volume of cases among said several courts.
