AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ARREST OF A PERSON ASSAULTING OR THREATENING AN INVESTIGATOR OF THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 the following paragraphs to section 63 A: —
- 3 Any person who commits an assault or assault and battery or
- 4 threatens bodily harm to any investigator of the commission in
- 5 the lawful performance of his duties or any person who refuses
- 6 or fails on command of such investigator to satisfactorily identify
- 7 himself when there is a reasonable cause to believe that the
- 8 person has committed a violation of this chapter in his presence,
- 9 may be arrested without a warrant by an authorized investigator
- 10 of the commission.
