By Mr. Sirianni of Winthrop, petition of Ralph E. Sirianni, Jr., for legislation to require a six hour driver training course as a prerequisite to obtaining a driver's license. Public Safety.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT REQUIRING ALL PERSONS TO TAKE A SIX HOUR DRIVER TRAINING COURSE AS A PREREQUISITE TO OBTAINING A DRIVER'S LICENSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All persons must complete a six hour driver's
2 training course in a classroom as a prerequisite to obtaining a
3 motor vehicle operator's license. This driver's training course
4 shall be approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles in
5 consultation with the Commissioner of Education. This course
6 may be given as part of the existing high school driver's training
7 program or by any licensed private driver's training school with
8 driver's education facilities approved by the Registrar of Motor
9 Vehicles.

1 SECTION 2. A person who has taken a full driver's educa-
2 tion course as prescribed by the Registry of Motor Vehicles and
3 has been certified by the Registrar as passing such a course shall
4 be exempt from this provision.

1 SECTION 3. A certificate showing completion of this course
2 must be attached to each license application when applying for
3 an appointment for a road test. This certificate must be approved
4 by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles.
