By Mr. Schneiders of Canton, petition of Paul A. Schneiders and Maurice E. Ronayne, Jr. (by vote of the town) relative to providing tenure of office until age seventy for James F. Meninno, incumbent of the office of highway superintendent of the town of Avon. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE OF OFFICE UNTIL AGE SEVENTY FOR JAMES F. MENINNO, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT OF THE TOWN OF AVON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 James F. Meninno, incumbent of the office of Highway
2 Superintendent of the town of Avon, shall hold said office during
3 good behavior until he reaches the age of seventy, unless
4 incapacitated by physical or mental disability from performing
5 the duties thereof. Said incumbent shall not be removed from
6 office, lowered in rank or suspended, except for just cause and
7 for reasons specifically given him in writing by the board of
8 selectmen in the manner provided by section forty-three of
9 chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.
