## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF STREAMLINING THE OPERATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of represen-  
3 tatives, and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is  
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation  
5 and study relative to the feasibility of establishing a separate  
6 agency apart from the commissioner of administration and  
7 similar to the General Services Administration of the Federal  
8 Government for the purpose of streamlining the operation of  
9 various agencies of the commonwealth.

10     Said commission may travel without the commonwealth and  
11 may require by summons the attendance and testimony of wit-  
nesses and the production of books and papers.
