AN ACT ESTABLISHING POLPIS ROAD IN NANTUCKET AS A STATE HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 or special law to the contrary, Polpis road, so-called, located on
3 the island of Nantucket and running from the town of
4 Nantucket to the village of Siasconset, shall be maintained by
5 the department of public works as a state highway under the
6 provisions of chapter eighty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
