AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALES OF COMPETITIVE FOODS AS A PART OF SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The thirteenth paragraph of section 1G of chapter 15 of the
2 General Laws, inserted by section 1 of chapter 871 of the acts of
3 1970, is hereby amended by adding the following
4 sentence: — The board shall not make any regulations or direc-
5 tive the effect of which would be to forbid a school, in which
6 lunches are served under a federally sponsored school lunch
7 program, from allowing the sale of competitive foods, by vending
8 machines or otherwise.
