AN ACT RELATIVE TO ADVANCE RETIREMENT PAYMENTS DURING THE PERIOD OF PROCESSING A RETIREMENT APPLICATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 98, as most recently amended by chapter 403 of the
3 acts of 1958, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 *Section 98.* Advance payments, period of processing applica-
6 tion. The state treasurer may make advance payments in an
7 amount not to exceed any retirement allowance actually due to
8 members of the state employees' retirement system or the
9 teachers' retirement system who are eligible for, and who have
10 filed application for, retirement, during such period as is
11 necessary for the processing of such application for retirement.
12 The state treasurer shall make rules and regulations governing
13 such payment.
