AN ACT RELATIVE TO DEATH BENEFITS OF WIDOWS OF CERTAIN JUDGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section 65C of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 931 of the
3 acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by inserting after the
4 word "offices", in line 18, the words: — or in the case of a judge
5 appointed after July thirty-first, nineteen hundred and fifty-six,
6 who has served continuously for ten years or more in such office
7 or offices.
