AN ACT INCREASING GROSS RECEIPTS OF INCOME ALLOWABLE FOR ELDERLY PERSONS UNDER THE TAX EXEMPTION FOR REAL ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 456 of the acts of 1970, is hereby
3 amended by striking out, in line 17, the words "six thousand"
4 and inserting in place thereof the words: — "six thousand five
5 hundred" and by striking out, in line 18, the words "seven
6 thousand" and inserting in place thereof the words: — seven
7 thousand five hundred.
