AN ACT LOWERING THE AGE OF TAX ABATEMENT ELIGIBILITY FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of  
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 1069 of  
3 the acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by striking out, in  
4 lines 4 and 7, respectively, the word "seventy" and inserting in  
5 place thereof, in each instance, the word: – sixty-five.

1 SECTION 2. , This act shall apply to taxes levied for the year  
2 nineteen hundred and seventy-three and subsequent years.
