AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN INSURANCE AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS AND SICK LEAVE FOR FEMALE TRAFFIC SUPERVISORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
2 law or ordinance to the contrary, female traffic supervisors,
3 who are subject to the provisions of chapter thirty-one, shall
4 be permitted to participate in group hospitalization, medical
5 and surgical insurance plans and shall be entitled to such sick
6 leave benefits and retirement benefits as are provided by
7 ordinance for regular employees.
