AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (6) of section 178F of chapter 149 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in chapter 774 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: —
4 In the case of any agency which shall be authorized to fix the
5 classification, title, and salary within the pay plan of the
6 commonwealth of any member of the professional staff of such
7 agency, such conditions of employment shall, in any such
8 bargaining involving members of such professional staff, include
9 compensation and hours of work; provided, however, that the
10 additional costs in any agreement relative to compensation or
11 hours of work reached in any such bargaining by any agency shall
12 be within funds appropriated to the agency.
