### AN ACT ELIMINATING TENURE FOR SUPERINTENDENTS AND TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 41 and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following section: —

4 *Section 41.* A teacher, or a superintendent, shall be notified  
5 in writing on or before April fifteenth whenever such person is  
6 not to be employed for the following school year. Unless said  
7 notice is given as herein provided, a teacher, or a superinten-  
8 dent, shall be deemed to be appointed for the following school  
9 year.
