*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law or any rule or
- 2 regulation of the board of registration of dispensing opticians,
- 3 said board shall waive the requirement of citizenship and shall
- 4 permit Jakow Kac to take the examination for qualification as a
