AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF WAREHAM AS THE CORPORAL EDWARD J. ANDRADE AND CORPORAL WAYNE T. SEVERINO MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The bridge at the intersection of interstate highway route 195
2 and Barlow Avenue located in the Rose Point section, so called,
3 of the town of Wareham shall be known and designated as the

5 Memorial Bridge. A suitable marker bearing such designation
6 shall be attached thereto by the department of public works. For
