## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO FEES FOR ENTERING NOTICE OF INTENTION OF MARRIAGE AND THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE THEREFOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 34 of chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out clause (42) and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following clause: —  
4 (42). For entering notice of intention of marriage and  
5 issuing certificates thereof, ten dollars, retaining for their own  
6 use or the use of the city or town according to law, five  
7 dollars for each certificate of intention and paying into the  
8 treasury of the commonwealth five dollars for the account of  
9 the Executive Office of Human Services for the creation and  
10 maintenance of programs for the prevention of family in-  
11 stability, including reconciliation for separated families.
